PLEASE CONTACT THE PARISH CENTER REGARDING HOSPITALIZATION OF PARISHIONERS

Because of a recent change in federal regulations, many hospitals are changing their policies to ensure patient privacy. One significant change that we have encountered is that hospitals are no longer as willing to notify churches when parishioners are admitted. **For that reason, if you or a family member are admitted to the hospital and you would like a visit from the pastoral staff, PLEASE contact the Parish Office and pass along this information.**

ATTENTION: For the month of June, the Lifeline Personal Response System group is waiving the usual installation fee (\$65.00). You will need to pay the shipping and handling charges (14.95) and the monthly service fee. There are information sheets and coupons on the Health and Senior Ministry bulletin board in the East entrance of the church.
