A Memorial Service for **Msgr. Stephen Paul Happel**, 59, was held on Friday, October 10th at SS. Peter and Paul Cathedral. Msgr. Happel died October 4th. He served Little Flower as Associate Pastor in 1970, and became a noted expert in systematic theology, religion, and culture. In September 2000 he was appointed as Dean of the School of Theology and Religious Studies at Catholic University of America. Pope John Paul II honored him in 2002 with the title "Chaplain to his Holiness" and Monsignor in the spring of 2002.

Margaret Lawley, 93, mother of Margaret Morse, died Wednesday, October 8th in Colorado. She was buried from the parish on Monday, October 13th. We pray for the repose of her soul and for those who mourn her death.
