Disciples in Mission is a spiritual formation program geared toward evangelization. The *Disciples in Mission* website summarizes the goals of the program: *to live our faith fully (Goal I), to share it with others (Goal II), and to transform*

the world in Christ (Goal III).

This program will be one of the cornerstones of our parish celebration of Lent this year. I think this program has two distinct advantages over many other parish programs. First, the program is based on the Sunday Mass readings. Second, parishioners can participate at different levels. Besides dining with some of the school children, you will be serenaded by the second grade. After lunch, you will make crafts with the children. The donation requested is \$3.50 per person.
