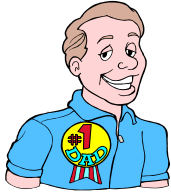


# HAPPY FATHER'S DAY



## DEAR PARISH FAMILY,

Green is the liturgical color of Ordinary Time. There is a rhythm to the Liturgical Year. Christmas and Easter are our major times of celebration. Advent and Lent are our times of preparation and renewal. During Ordinary Time, we focus

on Jesus' life and ministry.

Theologian John Powell once commented that studies have shown that green is the most relaxing color. He concluded that this demonstrated that God is the greatest psychologist since he made so much of the earth green. In our liturgical tradition, green has been the symbol of hope.

A personnel director of a large company once told me that there used to be a rhythm in people's work. Most workers had very busy times, less busy times, and, of course, vacation times. Today most workers are intensely busy all the time. Many have difficulty finding a good time to take a vacation. In his opinion, this was the cause of early burnout. Please remember to take some time for yourselves and your families this summer.
