### DEAR PARISH FAMILY,

Thanks to all who have completed and returned their stewardship cards. In our stewardship talks, we have spoken primarily about parish stewardship. The United Catholic Appeal supports our Archdiocesan home missions and shared ministries. This year our United Catholic Appeal Goal is \$57,000, which we believe is a very realistic goal in light of our previous giving. If you have not already returned your stewardship card, please do so as soon as possible. Returning the card is itself an act of stewardship because it frees staff and volunteers from using precious time making follow up calls.

This weekend, at the 10:30 a.m. Mass, we celebrate the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens. This represents a major step forward in our catechumens' and candidates' journey to full initiation into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Paragraph 41 of the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* explains the significance of this rite for them and for us: "Assembling publicly for the first time, the candidates who have completed the period of the precatechumenate declare their intention to the Church and the Church in turn, carrying out its apostolic mission, accepts them as persons who intend to become its members."

This Saturday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, is Little Flower School's All Class Reunion. The evening begins with Mass at 5 p.m., followed by a 6 p.m. Social Hour and 7 p.m. Dinner. After dinner, we will honor our 2004 Outstanding Alumni Award recipients as well as alumni from the classes of 1944, 1949, and 1954. Also, a permanent plaque recognizing the contributions of all the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, Indiana, who served at Little Flower from 1926 until 2000 will be presented to Sr. Jean Marie Cleveland, O.S.F., Congregational Minister, herself an alumna of Little Flower. Finally, Sr. Rosita, O.S.F., will be honored as the last Little Flower principal who was also a full-time teacher.
