

Dear Parish Family,

Today is the Third Sunday of Advent, commonly called *Gaudete Sunday*. The Latin word *gaudete* means *rejoice*. St. Paul wrote to the Philippians: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice! The Lord is near" (Philippians 4:4, 5).

Thanks to all who attended the Christmas party last Sunday. I was delighted at the number of people who

attended. Thanks to all who helped make it a success. Special thanks to Santa and Mrs. Claus for taking time out of their busy schedule to visit with the children of Little Flower.

Also, thanks to all the priests who assisted with the Penance Service Monday evening and all who helped prepare our second graders for their First Reconciliation.

Christmas is almost here. Whenever Christmas falls on Monday, it creates a certain amount of confusion in parishes.

Our Mass schedule for the Fourth Sunday of Advent will be our regular Mass schedule except there will be no Sunday evening 6 p.m. Mass. Masses will be Saturday evening at 5 p.m. and Sunday morning at 8:30 and 10:30 a.m. The choir Mass will be Saturday evening at 5 p.m. Some parishes are dropping some of their usual Sunday morning Masses. We have chosen not to change the morning schedule because we believe that the Fourth Sunday of Advent is important liturgically. The Liturgy for the Fourth Sunday of Advent focuses on Mary, the Mother of Jesus.

Christmas Masses will be at 3:30, 5:30, and 10:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve and at 9:00 a.m. on Christmas morning. The 10:00 p.m. Mass will be the traditional Midnight Mass.

Whenever Christmas falls on Monday, we are frequently asked if Catholics who attend Mass on Christmas Eve afternoon or evening can use that Mass to fulfill both the obligation to attend Mass and the obligation to attend Mass on Christmas. The answer is no. We are obliged to attend Mass both on the Fourth Sunday of Advent and on Christmas.

As a pastor I have to think about things I never had to be concerned with as an associate or as a resident priest. As part of your stewardship to the parish, please remember that the Church budget depends on both the collection for the Fourth Sunday of Advent and the collection for Christmas. Please do not misunderstand. I am ever-mindful of your constant and faithful generosity. It's just that in this special situation, this reminder may be helpful. Some people take this opportunity to make a generous contribution at the end of the calendar year for tax benefits.

My prayer for you is that you will have a blessed Christmas and even more blessed New Year.

### RCIA CHRISTMAS PARTY

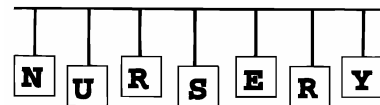
