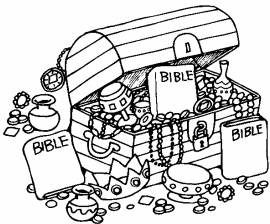
There is a special collection on Sunday, June 11th for the education of future archdiocesan priests. Please use the envelope provided in your regular envelope packet.
