



Dear Parish Family,

I would like to briefly update you on work in the church.

The platform was poured Monday, and we began using it on Friday for the school Mass. The concrete will need to cure several weeks before the terrazzo tile can be laid.

The new altar furnishings have been ordered. The altar was designed to replicate the smaller stone altars, which were based on the table in Leonardo da Vinci's *Last Supper*. The other pieces are all designed to complement the altar. It will take approximately three months to complete the furnishings. Again, special thanks to all those who contributed to enable us to have altar furnishings consistent with Fr. John's original vision for the church and the post-Vatican II Liturgy.

I think celebrating on the floor for two weeks was a good thing. Several people noted that the sound was better. Some people liked having everyone in two sections because it made the congregation seem larger. Still others liked the altar on the floor because they felt the Liturgy was more intimate. Because parishioners were sitting in different parts of the church from where they usually sit, some parishioners met parishioners they did not know. The one negative I heard was that some found it more difficult to see. In any case, thank you for your continued patience as this project is completed over the next few months.

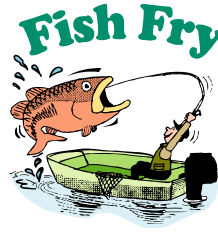


Surprise 60th Birthday Party
