**Dear Parish Family,**

Thank you for all the birthday greetings.

Today we welcome Sister Barbara Leonhard who is here for a mission appeal on behalf of the Oldenburg Franciscans. Sister Barbara presently teaches in the Spiritual Direction Internship at the Benedict Inn. She teaches occasional courses for the Lay Pastoral Ministry program in the Archdiocese and at St. Meinrad. Sister Barbara also offers retreats and spiritual direction and frequently leads parish workshops. She has herself been a missionary in Papua New Guinea and is therefore eager to help support their mission there.

This Friday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, is the Solemnity of the Assumption, a Holyday of Obligation. Masses will be at 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Wednesday is the opening day of school. We welcome all of our students, especially our new students, and their family. We also welcome back our administration, faculty, and staff. We will open the school year with the traditional Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit on Wednesday morning at 8:30 a.m.

As school opens, most of the work on the exterior of the church and the original entrance on the school is complete. The church looks almost new. The restoration of the original main entrance makes the school look more open and alive.

Once again this summer there have been rumors here on the Eastside that Little Flower Parish or Little Flower School is in trouble and in danger of closing. I hope the re-bricking of the church and the restoration of the main entrance of the school makes a strong statement to you, to the neighborhood, and to Eastside Catholics that Little Flower Parish *and* School are not only alive and well but thriving.

Finally, as a son of Little Flower and now pastor, I believe we have the most beautiful church in Indianapolis. First-time visitors are frequently in awe at the beauty of the church. The church is a work of art: the architectural design, the beautiful furnishings, especially the altars, the Stations of the Cross, the mosaics, and the stained glass windows.

Since I came in 2003, I have done my best to try to find out what happened to the original windows in the former sanctuary and where they are, if they still exist, with little success. More recently, I have tried to get as many pictures of them as possible in order to have them replicated. We are now ready to order them. The projected cost is approximately \$5,500, which is an excellent price. Many parishioners, especially those who were here when the church was dedicated, have strong feelings about the windows. If anyone would like to contribute to replicating the windows, we would welcome any donations, small or large. If you are interested in helping with this project, be assured that your gift will be restricted specifically to this use.

## Youth News

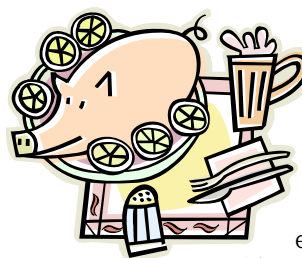
