Dear Parish Family,

Our 2008-2009 fiscal year ends on June 30. The last part of our fiscal year is always a challenging time for the Sunday Collection. Because of many conflicting activities at this time of year that often cause people to be away or attend another parish, we typically have a difficult time maintaining the collection at this time.

At this time last year, we were running slightly ahead of budget. *Currently we are running a budget deficit of \$20,000.* Thanks to all of you who have done your best to be faithful to your regular stewardship commitment in these challenging economic times. However, if you have fallen behind in your stewardship commitment and find yourself in a position to "make it up," please consider doing so by June 28th the last Sunday of this fiscal year. Because it is the end of the fiscal year, it is critical that we try to close the gap between the budget and the collection.

Summer has arrived. If you are like me, you are probably grateful for longer days and warmer weather. With warmer weather and summer activities, we sometimes become a little too casual in our dress for Sunday Eucharist. We always need to remember that we are coming together to celebrate the Eucharist of the Lord, and we also always need to be sensitive to our fellow parishioners.

The rummage sale and the silent auction showed significant increases, but virtually all areas outperformed last year! As planned, \$20,000 of these profits will to our parish operating budget and over \$31,500 will be placed in the restricted fund to assist with various capital projects. If there are funds remaining, our parking lot is in dire need of some attention!

A final thank you goes out to all of our volunteers and to all those who supported the festival in any way. It's not all about the financial outcome – our volunteers did an outstanding job and everyone who attended had a great time!
