THE GABRIEL PROJECT Launch is coming!

The Great Lakes Gabriel Project was started in Columbus, Indiana in 1999 and is endorsed by the Pro-Life Office of the Archdiocese and the USCCB. Last year (2007) over 175 pregnant Moms and families in Indiana were touched by the love of Christ through the Gabriel Project. We are relaunching the Gabriel Project at Little Flower in two weeks. Please note and save the date below for training/orientation.

What is The Gabriel Project?

Many mothers faced with crisis pregnancies feel abandoned by their families, the fathers of their babies and their communities. More and more, they represent all races, all cultures, all economic classes, and a wide range of ages. Some are homeless, and most feel alone and afraid. For too many, abortion seems the only answer.

Churches and pro-life service groups have sought ways to expand their embrace of women in difficult pregnancies. Now comes a way they can do so together—a way to combine the special power of prayer with a commitment to service—The Gabriel Project of Indiana! This project is supported by the Indiana Knights of Columbus - our pro-life heroes. With your help, the Little Flower Gabriel Project has helped 27 women this year. We have provided \$1,879 for rent assistance, and \$550 for utility assistance and other miscellaneous items. Most of the rent/utility assistance is targeted toward the period when a woman can't work shortly after the birth of her baby.
