

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Monday our nation celebrates the Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr. Both our parish office and our school will be closed in honor of Dr. King. Once again I quote from his "I Have A Dream" speech delivered on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial, Washington D.C., on August 28, 1963:

I have a dream that one day this nation will rise up and live out the true meaning of its creed: "We hold these truths to be self-evident: that all men are created equal."... I have a dream that my four children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character.

I often mention Matthew Kelly's quote that God's dream for us is that we become the-best-version-of-ourselves. I believe that God has the same dream for us as a nation. In his "I Have A Dream" speech, Martin Luther King suggested what that might mean. In that same speech, Dr. King reminded us that "unearned suffering is redemptive."

Monday also begins the Week of Prayer for Church Unity (January 18-25). The theme for 2016 is "Called to Proclaim the Mighty Acts of the Lord" (1 Peter 2:9). The Week of Prayer for Church Unity began as the Church Unity Octave. January 18 was formerly the feast of the Chair of St. Peter in Rome, and January 25 was and is the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. During this week, we all want to pray for the church unity:

Lord Jesus, you said that everyone will know that we are your disciples if there is love among us. Strengthened by your grace, may we work tirelessly for the visible unity of your Church, so that the Good News that we are called to proclaim will be seen in all our words and deeds. Amen.

Friday marks the 43rd anniversary of *Roe v Wade*, the Supreme Court decision legalizing abortion throughout the United States. "Since that tragic decision, more than 56 million children's lives have been lost to abortion, and many suffer that loss -- often in silence." In the United States, today is to be a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. The All-School Mass on Friday will be the Mass "For Giving Thanks to God for the Gift of Human Life." All are invited.

Finally, please note the flyer about next week's Pancake Breakfast and the announcement about next week's Ministry Fair in the "Stewardship of Time, Talent and Treasure" box. I hope as many of you as possible will attend the Pancake Breakfast and check out the Ministry Fair.


