Dear Parish Family,

The Third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday. The Latin word *gaudete* means *rejoice*. At the midpoint of Advent, we are called to rejoice because the coming of the Lord is near. As a sign of joy, the vestment color today is rose. Also, the third candle of the advent wreath is rose. Two verses from St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians capture the spirit of the day: "*Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice.... The Lord is near*" [4:4-5].

Today we welcome members of the Joseph and Veronica Thie family to our 10:30 a.m. Mass. One of our traditions is to present the Joseph and Veronica Thie Memorial Service Awards at the 10:30 a.m. Mass preceding the Christmas party. This award is awarded to nine Little Flower Catholic School sixth through

eighth graders who demonstrate a commitment to academics and service. The award consists of a plaque, a \$100 check made out to the student, and the inscription of the student's name on the permanent plaque in the school.

The children of Joseph and Veronica Thie established this award to honor their parents. Joe Thie worked for many years at St. Vincent Hospital. After his retirement, he worked for many more years as part of Little Flower's maintenance staff, especially in the church. Both he and Veronica were involved in parish organizations and activities. They helped establish the Adventuresome Group.

Tomorrow is the 20th anniversary of the death of former pastor Fr. Robert Borchertmeyer. Fr. Robert or Fr. Bob was killed in a traffic accident returning home from an Penance Service. Fr. Robert or Fr. Bob served as associate pastor of Little Flower from 1958-1968 and as pastor of Little Flower from 1985-1995. Please remember Fr. Robert in your prayers today.

After the terrorist attacks in Paris and San Bernardino, the United States is faced with balancing the protection of the American people from terrorism and the desperate situations of Syrian refugees. On November 17 (prior to the San Bernadino killings), Bishop Eusebio Elizondo, Chairman of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Committee on Migration, issued a statement on Syrian refugees. His statement can be found at http://www.archindy.org/archbishop/syria-2015.html. We all need to pray for the victims of terrorism and their families but also for all refugees from terrorism.

Due to the construction projects we have quite a few areas of new concrete on the property. This includes, the concrete pad outside the cafe (door #6), most of the sidewalk between the parking lot and church, and the front entrance of church including the south ramp leading to the front door.

Please be aware that during snowy or icy weather we will need to treat these areas with less product due to the harmful effects of ice melt on concrete less than one year old. There will be a mixture of ice melt and sand available at the front door of church. It needs to be used very sparingly. Also it will be important not to use other products, or even the product available for use at other doors on the newly treated areas. There will be shovels available at these locations as well, and keeping the areas clean with shovels is the best course of treatment. Above all, please use extreme care this winter on these areas that may not be as clear as they have been in the past.

As you can see from the weekly updates in the bulletin, we are still running a significant Sunday collection deficit at this time. As the end of the year approaches, please take a look at your weekly offering compared to what you had planned to give. If you have fallen behind and are able to make it up, the end of the calendar year presents an excellent opportunity to do so.


The Little Flower Athletic Commission is currently looking for volunteers to coach Girls Volleyball teams. Anyone interested needs to have experience with volleyball.
