Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Today we want to pray for all families that they will model themselves after the Holy Family. However, with all the violence in the world, we also want to pray for the human family that we all see ourselves as children of the same God and, therefore, brothers and sisters of one another.

Friday is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, a Holyday of Obligation. Masses will be Thursday evening at 6:00 p.m. and Friday morning at 9:00

a.m. It has also been designated as a Day of Prayer for World Justice and Peace. Of course, January 1 is also New Year's Day. The parish office will be closed on Friday, January 1.

The theme for Pope Francis' annual World Day of Peace message for 2016 is "Overcome Indifference and Win Peace." Pope Francis began his message for this year's celebration of the World Day of Peace with "God is not indifferent! God cares about mankind! God does not abandon us!" The following is a prayer to overcome indifference:

All too often, Lord, we turn away from the world's many problems, which seem too big, too complex, or too far away. Forgive us our indifference.

It is easier, Lord, to see only what is around us: our lives, our homes, our challenges. Forgive us our isolation.

Help us to see with *your* eyes: eyes which notice one another and help us understand.

Help us to dream *your* dream: of communities that reach out and dialogue and where diverse people creatively cooperate.

Help us to be people of solidarity and action, so moved by prayer, encounter, and understanding that peace can become a reality.

Amen.
