

Dear Parish Family,

This Thursday, November 1, is the Solemnity of All Saints, a holyday of obligation. Masses will be at 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. The 6:00 p.m. Mass will be our annual Mass of Remembrance. At this Mass, we remember all of those who were buried from Little Flower this past year. Please try to attend to support their families and to remember your own loved ones who now are part of the Communion of Saints in heaven.

Friday is All Souls Day, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. Praying for the dead has always been an important part of the Catholic tradition. Therefore, Masses will be at 8:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Although we rarely, if ever, have Mass on Friday evening, I thought it was important to give all of you who are unable to attend the 8:30 a.m. Mass the opportunity to celebrate All Souls Day. Please come and pray for your loved ones who have died and for all the faithful departed.

At all the Masses next weekend, we will celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Dedication of Little Flower Church. Although the church was actually dedicated on July 8, 1962, we thought it would be good to combine our celebration of the dedication with our annual All-Class Reunion. The readings will be the readings for the 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time, but the prayers of the Mass will be from the Mass on the Anniversary of the Dedication of a Church.
