Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.



#### Dear Parish Family,

Welcome to all those who have come to attend Fr. Dave Sullivan's Memorial Mass this Saturday at 5:00 p.m. Fr. Dave has a special place in the hearts of Little Flower parishioners.

As I mentioned last week, the U.S. Catholic bishops have launched a pastoral strategy of prayer and fasting to

address critical life, marriage, and religious liberty concerns. Besides the practices I mentioned last week, the bishops are encouraging Eucharistic Holy Hours for Life, Marriage, and Religious Liberty on the last Sunday of each month. Because we have perpetual adoration with exposition, I would simply encourage everyone to make a Holy Hour in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament some time next Sunday, January 27


