### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Raise the Standards

Dear Parish Family,

As I mentioned last week, the bishops of the United States are encouraging Eucharistic Holy Hours for Life, Marriage, and Religious Liberty on the last Sunday of each month. Because we have perpetual adoration with exposition, I would simply invite you to make a Holy Hour in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament some time today, January 27.

Archbishop Tobin's Mass for the East Deanery Mass will take place here at Little Flower on Tuesday, February 5, at 7:00 p.m. Catholics from throughout the deanery have been invited to attend. There will be a reception following the Mass.

As part of the Year of Faith, the Archdiocese is inviting each parishioner to contribute to the writing of a pastoral resource called "10 Things We Want You to Know About the Catholic Faith." This is designed to help deepen each participant's faith in Jesus Christ and appreciation of the Church, his Body.

As one component of this process, each parish is asked to hold a town-hall meeting to surface "10 Things We Want You to Know About the Catholic Faith." Our parish meeting will be Monday, February 11, at 7:00 p.m. in the St. Patrick Room in the parish center. Mark Erdosy will facilitate the meeting. Please mark your calendars and be part of this Year of Faith process.

Although no preparation is required, I would invite anyone who might be interested to read Vatican II's Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, *Lumen Gentium*. A copy of the document may be found online at <https://www.archindy.org/yearoffaith/resources.html>.

This Thursday we celebrate the feast of St. John Bosco. St. John Bosco was born August 16, 1815 and died on January 31, 1888. He founded the Salesians. Because he spent his priesthood ministering to young people, the Indianapolis CYO has named its highest award for him—the St. John Bosco medal. This medal is awarded annually to outstanding volunteers with youth. Recently I looked over the list of St. John Bosco award winners from Little Flower. Among the early award winners from Little Flower were: Edward J. Fillenwarth, Sr., 1954; Leo S. Evans, 1954; Mel A. Olvey, 1957; Joseph M. Delaney, 1959; Francis E. Fiddler, 1964; James V. Gavaghan, 1966; Henry J. Wolff, 1966; and John A. Huser, 1968. 1954 was the first year the St. John Bosco medal was awarded. Little Flower had two of the initial recipients of the award. If I missed anyone from the 1950's or 60's, I apologize. If you let me know, I will include their names next week.

Thanks to everyone who came last Saturday evening to celebrate our memorial Mass for Fr. Dave Sullivan. The turnout was excellent. This month we lost two long-time parishioners. On Sunday, January 6, Alvina Bauman Wurz died. Alvina was born January 16, 1926. She was the 11<sup>th</sup> baby baptized here at Little Flower. In fact, she was not baptized in the old church but in the temporary church at 10<sup>th</sup> & Bancroft. With the exception of a very few years, she lived her whole life here at Little Flower. On Tuesday, January 15, Art Meier died at the age of 100. Although he was in his 90's, when I first came to Little Flower, Art still was taking care of the lawn, the flowers, and the trees. Please pray for them and for their families.

Finally, with flu season upon us, if you have any symptoms of a cold or flu, please do not drink from the chalice.
