Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Prepare this week for the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent

First Reading: Micah 5:1-4A Second Reading: Hebrews 10:5-10 Gospel: Luke 1: 39-45

Mary's example in today's Gospel shows us the importance of preparing for Christmas through actions and attitudes of service. Paul tells the Hebrews that God desires not their sacrifices and burnt offerings but a humble and obedient heart. We are called to be servants of the Lord and of each other.

### Practice:
