

Dear Parish Family,

Tomorrow we celebrate the Solemnity of the Nativity of John the Baptist. John the Baptist was the last prophet of the Old Testament and the first prophet of the New Testament. Therefore,

he was the bridge between the two Testaments. Also, he is called the precursor because he fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah quoted by Mark: "As it is written in Isaiah the prophet: 'Behold, I am sending my messenger ahead of you; he will prepare your way'" [1:2].

In John's Gospel, John the Baptist said about himself and Jesus "'He must increase; I must decrease'" [3:30]. St. Augustine noted that the dates of this feast and Christmas were appropriate. After the birth of John (June 24), the days grow shorter. After the birth of Jesus (December 25), the days grow longer. "'He must increase; I must decrease'" [3:30].

Saturday is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. It is also my 38th anniversary of ordination. The thirty-eight years have passed very quickly as have the ten years I have been pastor at Little Flower. On Saturday at Sacred Heart I will celebrate the wedding of a woman whom I taught when she was in 6th grade at St. Christopher's.

Congratulations to Andi Barnett and Celena Williamson, both of the Little Flower class of 2010, who were also members of Scecina's Class 2A Softball State Championship team. Celena was one of two managers and Andi played outfield and was a pinch runner. For Elizabeth Lee and Cena Tamer, it was an amazing way to end their high school career! Andi and Celena and the rest of next year's team have the challenge of trying to duplicate the success of this year's team.

On Wednesday, June 12, the Adventuresome Group traveled to St. Vincent de Paul in Shelby County for Mass and a tour of the church. It was awesome! St. Vincent's has so many historical artifacts, including the top of the altar from the original log cabin church. We then attended the Daughters of Isabella annual salad luncheon at the Shelbyville K of C. Finally, we toured St. Joseph Church in Shelbyville.
