Dear Parish Family,

It is hard to believe that we are already into August! Little Flower Catholic School will open on August 14. Parishes with schools tend to operate on a school year calendar. Most parish programs slow down or stop during the summer. With the opening of school next week, Little Flower parish will get back into high gear.

Tuesday we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. The Transfiguration is one of three times in the New Testament when we hear the voice of God the Father. Jesus' transfiguration not only prepared his disciples for his upcoming passion, death, and resurrection but also reminded them and continues to remind us that Jesus came to bring us fullness of life beginning in this life and culminating in the next life.

Friday is the feast of St. Benedicta of the Cross, a contemporary saint. Edith Stein was born in Germany in 1891 of Jewish parents. She converted to Catholicism in 1922 and became a Carmelite nun in 1923 with the name Sr. Benedicta of the Cross. In 1942, she was arrested, transported to Poland, and killed at Auschwitz.

On Friday, July 26, an estimated 80 Mormon young people accompanied by 15 adults came to Little Flower during day two of their three-day retreat. When they arrived at 10:00 a.m., Kevin Gawrys and I spoke with them about servant leadership. From 10:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. (with time out for a hamburger and hot dog lunch), they demonstrated servant leadership through hard work. They cleaned under and between the pews in church. They painted the cafeteria pillars. They cleaned, scrubbed and scraped cafeteria tables and chairs. They pulled 12 bags full of weeds. They moved furniture and hauled trash, filling an entire dumpster. Finally, they set up and programmed our new computer lab.
