Dear Parish Family,

Last week we were privileged to hear Brother Roy Smith, C.S.C., ask for our prayers and financial

support for the Holy Cross missions in Black Africa. He said several things that are worth thinking about or remembering.

The first were the two sayings he presented to us: "If God will bring you to it, God will bring you through____it" and "Don't worry about tomorrow, God is already there. Hearken to the Lord's voice."

The statistics he presented were both exhilarating and sobering:

Black Africa is one of the church's most vibrant communities. Statistics show that over 1,000 converts enter the church every day and that there are now over 130 million Catholic Christians in Black Africa. There are many vocations to the priestly and religious life. It is simply the fastest growing segment of our church.

...right now there are more African Brothers of Holy Cross in West Africa than there are American Holy Cross religious.

We should be exhilarated by the growth of the Catholic Church in Black Africa, but we should be sobered when we think of the Catholic Church in Western Europe and the United States. Today we are told that the Catholic Church in the United States is losing more members than any other Christian denomination. It is estimated that 31.4% of Catholics attend Mass on any given Sunday. Only 23% of Catholic attend Mass every Sunday. The number of Catholic priests in the United States has dropped from 58,909 in 1975 (the year I was ordained) to 38,964 in 2012.

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus challenges the Pharisees and the Sadducees for their inability to read "the signs of the times." Therefore, the question we probably all need to ask ourselves is what these numbers are telling us.

If anyone was not here last weekend or did not have extra money for the second collection for the Holy Cross missions in Black Africa, you can still contribute by placing your donation, clearly marked for the Holy Cross missions, in this weekend's or next weekend's collection.

Finally, congratulations to Charlie Withem on being named Catholic Layman of the Year by the Bishop Chatard Assembly of the Knights of Columbus for his service to Church and Community. Charlie's service is most visible in Church. However, over the years, he has volunteered in many capacities here at Little Flower and in the large church community.


