Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Dear Parish Family,

This Monday, September 2, is Labor Day. Therefore, Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. There will be no 5:30 p.m. Communion Service. Also, both the Parish Office and Little Flower Catholic School will be closed for the holiday.

I would encourage all those who are able to attend Mass on Monday. Today too many people are unemployed or underemployed. Too many people who need and want full-time jobs can only find part-time jobs. Many workers do not earn a living wage. Workers need more job opportunities.

After several meetings of our *Connected in the Spirit* cohort (Holy Spirit, Little Flower, Our Lady of Lourdes, and St. Bernadette), we are almost ready to make our recommendation to the Archdiocese. As you may remember from previous bulletin announcements, there are four recommended models. One or more of these models can be part of our final recommendation for our four parishes.

1. **MODEL ONE: LINKED PARISHES**→Linked parishes happen when two or more parishes share a pastor. Linked parishes do as many things as possible cooperatively especially given that the pastor/administrator is striving to serve two or more separate parishes.
2. **MODEL TWO: MERGED PARISH**→Merged or consolidated parishes create a new parish configuration which is able to provide many more activities and opportunities than the original parishes could have managed on their own.
3. **MODEL THREE: PARTNERSHIP-PARISHES**→Parishes enter into partnerships with other parishes when they create joint programs, share staff when appropriate to enhance the quality of ministry and practice good stewardship of resources, and share in-services or retreats for parish pastoral councils, finance councils, or parish committees.
4. **MODEL FOUR: IN SOLIDUM TEAM**→Three or more parishes (often four or five parishes) are served by a team of priests, with one being named the moderator of the team.

Prior to making our recommendation, there will be a meeting of parishioners of the four parishes at **4 p.m. next Sunday, September 8, at Holy Spirit**. If you are able, please try to attend.

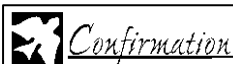
