

LF BENEFITS FROM GRANTS!

Over the past several months, we have been working with the Better Buildings Near Eastside Neighborhood Sweeps Program in evaluating and improving energy efficiency.

The fluorescent lighting that exists in our parish office and school is becoming obsolete due to more energy efficient methods of lighting. We have obtained a grant in the amount of \$20,000.00 that has replaced all of the lighting in and outside of the parish office. If you are in the building you will notice much improved lighting that is more energy efficient. This should result in utility savings as well.

We have obtained a similar grant for the school. Because of the size of our building, this grant will only allow us to change some of the lights. We will concentrate on the hallways, the outside lighting, and functioning lighted exit signs.

We are obviously very grateful as this is work that must be completed over the next year, and these grants have greatly reduced the money we need to do this work
