Today those who are attending RCIA will move into the second stage of the RCIA process as we celebrate the Rite of Acceptance & Welcoming at the 8:30 a.m. Mass. In this rite, they are asked to publicly declare their intentions to continue their journey towards becoming Catholic and are asked to more fully embrace the Gospel message with the help of God. They are signed with the Cross to show that they belong to Christ. Also, in this rite, the parish community has the opportunity to more fully participate in and pray for those in the RCIA process. We encourage all parishioners to reach out to them as fellow members of the household of Christ.

Friday we will remember the 50th anniversary of John F. Kennedy's assassination on Friday, November 22, 1963. 
