### **BULLETIN DEADLINE**

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent.

On Ash Wednesday, we will celebrate Mass and distribute ashes at 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Also, every Friday evening during Lent, there will be Stations of the Cross and Communion at 5:30 p.m.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. The law of abstinence requires Catholics 14 years of age and older to abstain from eating meat. The law of fasting requires Catholic from the age of eighteen until their fifty-ninth birthday to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The Church defines fasting as one main meal a day and two smaller meals which if added together would not be larger than the main meal.

The parishioners of Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Bernadette will join us for our **Lenten Penance Service on Monday, March 10, at 7 p.m. here at Little Flower.** Our RCIA candidates and those children preparing for First Communion will also join us. This year our Lenten Penance Service is very early in Lent. I think that this can help us make our Lenten journey more focused and beneficial. Also, all five Sundays of March there will a bulletin insert on the Rite of Penance.

Besides ashes on Ash Wednesday, we will be giving a small remembrance to everyone who comes to Mass on the First Sunday of Lent, March 8 and 9. This year's Lenten remembrance will be a small crucifix with the words of John 3:16 on the back. Please be here to get yours which will serve as a reminder of God's superabundant love for us: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life."

Lent, however, is not all penance. One of our Lenten highlights is our weekly Fish Fry each and every Friday during Lent except Good Friday. Serving begins at 4:30 p.m. and continues until 7:00 p.m. I want to encourage everyone to attend and to invite family, friends, and neighbors to attend. The Fish Fry is a wonderful opportunity for parishioners, family, friends, and neighbors to socialize.

Each year the Fish Fry earns the parish approximately \$9,000. This money is included as ordinary income in our annual budget. In the final analysis, the success of the fish fry depends on the numbers who attend. The more people who attend each week, the more successful the fish fry will be. I am profoundly grateful to all who will help with the Fish Fry this year.




