## Dear Parish Family,

Our Elect, our former Catechumens and Candidates, are in their final stage of preparation for their baptism or reception into the Church at the Easter Vigil. Part of that final preparation includes participation in the Scrutinies on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent.

These rites help deliver the Elect from the power of sin and Satan, help protect them against temptation, and help give them strength in Christ. The celebration of the Scrutinies also reminds our entire parish community of the need to reflect on our own sins and our need for God's help. This year the Gospel readings for the Scrutinies come from Cycle A of the Lectionary: the story of the Samaritan women at the well for the First Scrutiny, the story of the healing of the man born blind for the Second Scrutiny, and the story of the raising of Lazarus for the Third Scrutiny.

We celebrated the First Scrutiny at the 5 p.m. Mass last Sunday. Today we celebrate the Second Scrutiny at the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Next week we will celebrate the Third Scrutiny at the Sunday 6 p.m. Mass. Please welcome our Elect as they prepare for the Easter Sacraments.

This Wednesday, April 2, every parish will participate in *The Light Is On For You* initiative. Priests in every parish in the Archdiocese will hear confessions from 6:30-8:00 p.m. this Wednesday. Although those who regularly celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation are welcome, this initiative is primarily directed to those who do not regularly receive the sacrament of reconciliation. For those of you who may want to confess to a priest who does not know you, you may go to any Catholic church in Indianapolis this Wednesday from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. for confession.
