#### Dear Parish Family,

Welcome to any visitors who have come to enjoy Summerfest 2014 with us.

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension. This Solemnity reminds us that the mission and ministry of Jesus has been entrusted to the Church. During the time between Ascension and Pentecost, the Church asks us to pray for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. We also should pray that we will be open to the presence, power, and activity of the Holy Spirit within us, within the Church, and within the world.

In last Sunday's homily, I read the Archbishop May 21, 2014 *Connected in the Spirit* letter. His letter may be found as an insert in today's bulletin. In his letter, the Archbishop wrote, "I am also certain that God is constantly working through us to advance the work of His Church, leading us through sorrow to new and more abundant life."

As you know, Little Flower was part of the cohort that also included Holy Spirit, Our Lady of Lourdes, and St. Bernadette. One paragraph of the Archbishop's letter outlines his decisions concerning our cohort:

Saint Bernadette Parish will merge into Our Lady of Lourdes Parish on November 30, 2014. Holy Spirit Parish, Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, and St. Therese of the Child Jesus (Little Flower) Parish will establish a partnership. Under a partnership model, the parishes will create joint programs and share staff and services.

In the next few months, we especially want to pray for the parishioners of St. Bernadette. If any St. Bernadette parishioners attend Mass here at Little Flower, please do your best to make them feel welcome.

Wednesday is the 29<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of Fr. Bernard Gerdon. Fr. Gerdon was associate pastor at Little Flower from May 16, 1953 to February 9, 1955 and from October 7, 1957 to May 17, 1960.

Finally, please take care of our new hymnals. This includes not allowing children to play with them. Ribbons have been pulled out of the hymnals. In at least one case, the ribbons were pulled out, and the adhesive end stuck to the pages of the hymnal. Please remember that the majority of the hymnals were donated in honor or memory of loved ones.


