Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

**Dear Parish Family,**

The parish staff and I want to wish all fathers a very blessed and happy Father's Day. Parents play a critical role in the lives of their children. Thank you to all the fathers in our parish and all the men of our parish who assume a parental role in the lives of children.

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. We celebrate our faith in three Persons in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Today's Solemnity teaches us that all authentic love is self-giving. *"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life"* [John 3:16].

As part of his *Connected in the Spirit* decisions, Archbishop Tobin has assigned goals to each cohort. As you know, our cohort included Holy Spirit, Our Lady of Lourdes, St. Bernadette, and Little Flower. St. Bernadette is to merge into our Lady of Lourdes, and Holy Spirit, Our Lady of Lourdes, and Little Flower are to be partnership parishes. Although I will not be required to celebrate sacraments at another parish, one of the goals assigned to our cohort by the Archbishop is that we are to "Coordinate Mass schedules, consolidating or eliminating poorly attended Masses." Although there are no immediate plans to make any changes to our Mass schedule, I wanted you to know now that as we continue the *Connected in the Spirit* process, it is possible that we may need to adjust our Mass schedule to reflect changes in Mass attendance. Of course, we would not do so without consultation with the parish.

When Tom thanked you last Sunday for all you did to make Summerfest 2014 a success and announced that we had made approximately \$76,000 from the festival, I sensed excitement and electricity in Church. I cannot thank you enough for all you did to make the festival a success.

The Eastside is frequently in the news for all the wrong reasons. One of the policemen working the festival, a member of another parish, commented how easy it is to work our festival. When I lived at St. Christopher, St. Christopher had more festival problems than we have ever had here. St. Simon's festival has more problems than we have here. One family from St. Simon's told me how much they enjoyed our festival. They found access to the festival easy, lines were shorter, and the rides were longer.

Two Sisters of St. Francis with ties to Little Flower died this past week. Sr. Kathleen McShay died on Wednesday, June 4. Sr. Kathleen grew up in Our Lady of Lourdes parish. She was assigned to Little Flower from 1967 to 1973 and then as chaplain at Community Hospital from 1973 to 1979. On Tuesday, June 3, Sr. Carmen de Barros (formerly Sr. Francis Mary) died. Sister Carmen taught at Scecina Memorial High School from 1954 to 1967 and from 1975 to 1977. Please pray for them, their families, and the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg.
