Cultural Exchange and Ministry Opportunity!

Scecina High School will be accepting eleven foreign exchange students from China and Thailand for the 2014-2015 academic school year. These exchange students are serious about their high school education and have picked Scecina because of its fine reputation as an excellent school. They will be arriving in just a few short weeks! These students are interested in learning about the American culture as they become part of an American family and want to offer your family the opportunity to learn about their culture. In addition to providing a loving home you will also be given the opportunity to share your faith with a wonderful child who has never heard about the love of God. As a host family, you will receive \$400 a month to help with the expenses of an additional person living in the home. If you have a child attending Scecina, he/she will receive \$1000 scholarship toward their tuition. The exchange students will be responsible for all of their expenses (for school and all extracurricular activities). You do not need to have a child at Scecina in order to be a host family but you will need to provide transportation. The student may share a room with a sibling of the same gender. 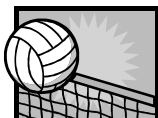
