SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

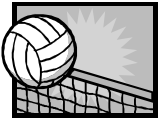

Cultural Exchange and Ministry Opportunity!

Seccina High School will be accepting eleven foreign exchange students from China and Thailand for the 2014-2015 academic school year. These exchange students are serious about their high school education and have picked Seccina because of its fine reputation as an excellent school. They will be arriving in just a few short weeks! These students are interested in learning about the American culture as they become part of an American family and want to offer your family the opportunity to learn about their culture. In addition to providing a loving home you will also be given the opportunity to share your faith with a wonderful child who has never heard about the love of God. As a host family, you will receive \$400 a month to help with the expenses of an additional person living in the home. If you have a child attending Seccina, he/she will receive \$1000 scholarship toward their tuition. The exchange students will be responsible for all of their expenses (for school and all extracurricular activities). You do not need to have a child at Seccina in order to be a host family but you will need to provide transportation. The student may share a room with a sibling of the same gender.
