Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. **Dear Parish Friends,**

Next Sunday, Sr. Norma Rocklage, O.S.F., a Sister of St. Francis, Oldenburg, and Executive Director of Education Formation Outreach at Marian University, will be here to ask for our prayers and financial support for the missionary activities of the Oldenburg Franciscans.

Currently, the Oldenburg Franciscans work in the inner city in Cincinnati and St. Louis, in Appalachia in Kentucky, among the Native Americans in New Mexico, and Montana, among Hispanics in several cities and states, including Batesville, Indiana, and with battered women's groups in Quincy, Illinois. For fifty years, Sisters of St. Francis worked in Papua, New Guinea. During their years there, they helped form a community of native Sisters. Although they no longer serve in Papua, they continue to send financial resources to the community they helped found.

Please be as generous as possible.

On this date in 1978, Pope Paul VI died. Pope Francis will beatify Pope Paul VI Oct. 19 during the closing Mass of the extraordinary Synod of Bishops on the family. Pope Paul VI reconvened the Second Vatican Council after the death of St. Pope John XXIII, presided over three of the four sessions of the Council, promulgated the decrees of the Council, and oversaw the implementation of the Council's reforms.

As many of you know, Fr. Jim Farrell and I were ordained by Pope Paul VI on June 29, 1975. If I have a memory of him at our ordination, it was the warmth in his eyes when I looked into them.

August 6<sup>th</sup> is remembered for another reason. August 6 and August 9 are the anniversaries of the dropping of nuclear bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945. As we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of Jesus, the Prince of Peace, this would be a good day to pray for world peace in these troubled times.

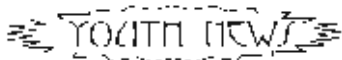
