Thank you for all the birthday wishes, cards, and gifts on the occasion of my 65^{th} birthday this past Wednesday. I appreciate your thoughtfulness.

This weekend we welcome Sr. Norma Rocklage, O.S.F., a Sister of St. Francis, Oldenburg, and Executive Director of Education Formation Outreach at Marian University. She is here to ask for our prayers and financial support for the missionary activities of the Oldenburg Franciscans. As most you know, the Oldenburg Franciscans staffed Little Flower Catholic School from its beginning until Sr. Alice Ann left in 1993. Throughout Scripture, Jesus calls us to feed the hungry, cloth the naked, provide shelter to the homeless and visit the sick. How will you answer Jesus' call to serve? On any given day there are many Catholic patients at Indiana University, Methodist and Riley Hospitals. It is our tradition to provide daily Holy Communion to our hospitalized brothers and sisters. There is currently an urgent need for ministers to bring the Eucharist to these patients. (Bilingual ministers are especially needed.) I invite you to prayerfully consider this call to serve. You need not be a current Eucharistic Minister in your parish as volunteers are commissioned for the hospital after being trained. Training is provided by the hospital and chaplaincy service. Scheduling is flexible. Normally it takes two to three hours to visit the patients. Volunteers are asked to serve once a week. Parking at the hospital is provided for volunteers.
