SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Thanks to all who attended the Parish Picnic last Sunday. It is always good to see older and younger parishioners, long-time and newer parishioners. The turnout was good. Because of the good weather (not too hot, not too cold), everyone seemed to want to stay longer. I think everyone had enough to eat although we were running out of sides by the end of dinner, which can be considered a good thing. The scavenger hunt for the younger children, the kickball game for the older children, and Bingo for the adults were all well received.

Special thanks to Pat Gandolph and the Parish Life Commission, Peggy Clegg, the Men's Club who organized the set up and clean up, and Sandy Clegg who organized the kickball game, Ann Schlosser who organized the scavenger hunt, and all the older and younger volunteers who helped with the Parish Picnic. It was really impressive to see so many people jump in to help.

Both the turnout for the picnic and the number of volunteers are a testament to the vitality of our parish. We have much for which to be grateful!

Also, the children's Liturgical Choir sang at the 10:30 Mass. During Mass, the 2013-2014 winners of the Hazel Elizabeth Gallagher Holdaway Service Awards were recognized. One student is recognized each quarter of the school year. The 2013-2014 winners were Caroline Downs, Addy Turner, Alice Hughey, and Elijah Clegg. They were presented a certificate of recognition, and their names will be inscribed on a permanent plaque in school. Also, the students receive a monetary award that is given as a credit to the student's tuition account.

Hazel Holdaway raised her five children in Little Flower. All five children were baptized by Fr. Charles Duffey, the founding pastor of Little Flower. All five attended Little Flower School. When her oldest daughter began First Communion classes, Hazel herself chose to become Catholic. She had such great appreciation and gratitude for what she and her children received at Little Flower that even after she left Little Flower Parish in 1963, she continued to send a check every month to Little Flower. In gratitude to her, her family and friends fund this award.

During the summer, many improvements were made in our school building. One of the biggest projects was replacing all the light fixtures with energy efficient fixtures and bulbs. Second, the two pre-school rooms received a complete makeover. Blackboards were removed, walls were painted, new white boards and tack boards were installed, and new subfloors and carpeting were installed. Also, new furniture was ordered for both rooms. New tables were purchased for Duffey Hall. Finally, the gym was repainted. What a difference new lighting and a new paint job can make! Very special thanks to all those helped with these projects. I especially want to thank the Men's Club members who have taken such an active role in helping with the gym.

Finally, please do not forget **Little Flower's Explanatory Mass this Thursday evening, August 28, at 7 p.m. in church.** It will last no longer than 90 minutes. This is not a real Mass, but a simulated Mass with explanation of the various parts of the Mass. Although this is directed especially to our school parents, we are inviting all of our parishioners to attend to better understand what we celebrate each Sunday.
