Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. Today, then, is the last Sunday of this Church Year. At all the Masses today, we commission and re-commission all liturgical ministers except Eucharistic Ministers. We thank all the lectors, servers, music ministers, greeters, ushers, and arts and environment ministers for the ministry, their service, to our community.

Also, last Sunday we celebrated the Rite of Enrollment with our Confirmation candidates at the 6:00 p.m. Mass. Our young people are both the present and the future of our Church. During these months of preparation, please pray that they will open their minds and hearts to the working of the Holy Spirit within them so that when they receive the sacrament, they will answer God's call to witness their faith, love, and hope to others.

Thanks to all those who supported our PTO Bingo on Saturday, November 15, either by attending or by working. The monies they raised will enrich the Little Flower Catholic School experience for our students.

Also, special thanks to the Men's Club who raked all the leaves and trimmed the bushes on Saturday, November 15.

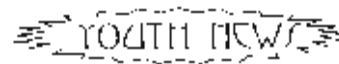
