Dear Parish Family,


This weekend our First Communion candidates are celebrating the Rite of Illumination at the Sunday 8:30 a.m. Mass. The children have been learning about how we celebrate as a family and as God's people. This rite reinforces what the children have been learning and how important it is to set aside every Sunday to attend Mass with God's family and celebrate the day of the Lord. They will receive a lit candle from their parents. The candle represents the "Light of Christ" that was given to them at baptism and reminds us that Jesus is the "Light of the World."

This Sunday is also World Marriage Day. Saturday is Valentine's Day. Congratulations to all engaged and married couples. According to Robert Sternberg, consummate love or married love has three dimensions: passion, intimacy, and commitment. The marriage of two Christians, however, always has a fourth dimension, a sacramental dimension.
