Dear Parish Family,

Next Sunday, April 26, at the 10:30 a.m. Mass, fourteen second graders and two third graders will receive their First Communion. Because there are not a large number of First Communicants this year, there will be ample room for everyone who wishes to attend. Since Little Flower parishioners are known for their love for the children of our parish, as recently evidenced by your support for our capital campaign, I would encourage you to come and share this special day with our children.

For most of us, especially those of us who are older, our First Communion was a very special day in our lives. Celebrating First Communion with our First Communicants not only supports them but gives us an opportunity to remember our own First Communion and to rekindle our faith in the Eucharist.

Tuesday is the feast of St. Anselm. St. Anselm is credited with defining theology as "faith seeking understanding." Because we live in a pluralistic society, it is more important than ever that we not only constantly deepen our faith but also deepen our understanding of our faith.

Last week I received an e-mail from an 89 year old gentleman who many years ago volunteered at the Tribunal. In the mid 1930's, he attended St. Teresa of Avila School in Summit, New Jersey. However, he wrote that they taught their students to pray, "Little Flower, in this hour, show thy power." He believes he has repeated this prayer a number of times every day since 1936. I found his lived devotion to St. Therese inspirational! It is interesting that I do not remember being taught this prayer. Tom remembers hearing it, and I heard a variation of it at a kickball game this past week.

Finally, please pray for the repose of the soul of Sr. Jacinta Stein, O.S.F. Sister taught second grade here at Little Flower during the 1959-1960 school year.
