Dear Parish Family,

As we celebrate my 40th anniversary of ordination this weekend at the 10:30 a.m. Mass, I want to welcome and thank all those who have come to celebrate with me. Likewise, I want to thank all of you who have

worked hard to make this celebration possible for me.

After 20 years in school together, both Fr. Jim Farrell and I were ordained by Pope Paul VI on June 29, 1975, the Solemnity of Sts. Peter & Paul, Apostles, in St. Peter's Square. When we learned that we were going to be ordained by Pope Paul VI, Msgr. Bosler, then Little Flower's pastor, decided to organize a pilgrimage to our ordination. Ninety-three people made the pilgrimage to Rome.

I would like to share two brief stories about the ordination. Three hundred fifty-nine of us from all over the world were ordained in one ceremony. At the practice the day before, someone asked how long the ordination would take. The papal master of ceremonies said it would take three hours. We processed in when the bells of St. Peter's were ringing 7 p.m., and we were processing out as they were ringing 10 p.m.

During the ceremony, each of us went up to Pope Paul VI twice, once for the imposition of hand and once for the sign of peace. In pictures and at audiences and ceremonies, Pope Paul VI appeared distant. However, when I looked into his eyes, I saw great warmth.

My mother, brother, and aunt made the pilgrimage. After my First Mass in Rome, we flew to England and then to Ireland. In Ireland, we visited several of my father's relatives and even found an aunt of my mother with whom the family had had no contact since the mid-1950's. After they left for home, I remained in London at the parish where I had served as deacon and had a First Mass there before returning to Indianapolis.

Pope Francis' most recent encyclical LAUDATO SI' on Care for our Common Home can be found online at http://w2.vatican.va/content/francesco/es/encyclicals/documents/papa-francesco_20150524_enciclica-laudato-si.html. If you listen to the news, you will hear many voices supporting the Pope's challenge to all of us but also many voices that challenge what Pope Francis has written. Therefore, it would be good for all of us to read it for ourselves.

The theme of this year's Fortnight for Freedom is "Freedom to Bear Witness." If you did not read Archbishop Tobin's column in the June 21st edition of *The Criterion*, I would encourage you do to so as we prepare to celebrate Independence Day on July 4th.

I will be on vacation from Tuesday, June 30, until Monday, July 13. During this time, there will be no weekday Masses here at Little Flower. Weekday Masses at Holy Spirit are 8:30 a.m. Monday through Saturday and 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday. Please note that there will be an 8:30 a.m. at Holy Spirit on July 4.
