

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.



We will view a "Dan Rather Reports" filmed as he travels to Jamaica, the epicenter of the scamming industry. Rather rides along with the local "Lottery Scam Task Force" and confronts one man suspected of perpetrating lottery scams against Americans. You will also learn how to protect yourself against potentially fraudulent practices and how to reduce those annoying phone calls. Experts from the Senior Medicare Patrol project will present the information along with staff from the Office of the Attorney General. SHIP staff will be on hand to answer Medicare questions.
