Dear Parish Family,

Thank you to all those who helped with our school clean-up on Saturday, August 8. Probably 80-100 men, women, and children, including most of the teachers, helped get the school ready for opening day. As Joe Reid, our maintenance director, said to me at the end of the day, "When Little Flower has a need and people are asked, they always come."

Little Flower School opens for the 2015-2016 school year this Monday, August 17, with a Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit at 8:30 a.m. All are invited to join our faculty and students to pray for a successful school year.

This year we have several new teachers. New teachers include:

- Pre-4's: Tracy Erdosy, a parishioner and parent of two Little Flower School students, taught developmentally delayed preschool for several years before staying home with her children and doing home day care.
- Kindergarten: Sally Lamping was a highly regarded teacher at Our Lady of Lourdes before moving to a private school to teach Kindergarten for seven years. This year we will have two kindergarten classes.
- First Grade: Nicole Ash has taught a K-1 classroom for students with hearing disabilities in Cincinnati for the past six years.
- Second Grade: Cassie Echegaray, also a Little Flower parishioner, begins her teaching career after graduating from Trine University as an engineer and working in that field for three years. Besides two kindergarten classes, we will have two 2nd grade classes.
- Third Grade: Brooke Anderson, formerly Brooke Braun, returns to Little Flower after taking time off when her children were very young and then teaching two years in a public school.
- Sixth Grade: Zane Galyan has taught 1st and 2nd and 5th grades in Bloomington, IN. Zane was married this past summer!
- Music: Jeff Crays replaced Miss Eckrich during the second semester last year. He is attended Little Flower School during his early elementary school days and plays the trumpet with the parish choir at Christmas and Easter.

Our Sunday morning Religious Education program for children who do not attend Catholic schools will begin on Sunday, August 23, from 9:30 a.m. to 10:25 a.m. Registration is still open for children in kindergarten through eighth grade who attend public schools. Please call the parish office to register. Living in a secular culture as we do, our children need formal religious education more than ever before in our country's history!

Finally, many people have asked why the candles are no longer on the altar. When candles are situated at both ends of the altar as they were, they seem to frame the altar, thereby making the altar appear smaller. Placing the candles elsewhere in the sanctuary, I think, makes the altar look larger and the sanctuary more expansive. Therefore, I wanted to try some different placements for the candles.
