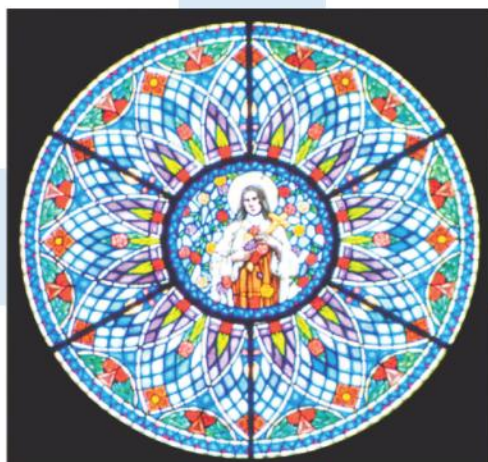

Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Dear Parish Family,

This Monday, September 7, is Labor Day. Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. There will no 5:30 p.m. Communion Service. Also, the parish office and school will be closed. Labor Day celebrates the contributions of all workers to the well-being of our country. It is also a day to pray for the unemployed and underemployed.

Please plan to attend our Parish Picnic next Sunday, September 13, following the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Because of the construction this summer, the picnic will be held on the blacktop. This will limit parking all weekend. Also, due to the picnic, parking in the parking lot will be restricted beginning around 9:45 a.m. Thank you for your cooperation.

Hurricane Katrina slammed into New Orleans on August 29, 2005. One of the parishes that was especially hard hit was St. Gabriel's Parish in New Orleans. We made a couple of donations to help them in their rebuilding.

Last week I received a letter from the current pastor, Fr. John Payne, thanking us for our support. I would like to share with you three paragraphs from that letter:

We recognize in a special way that you personally contributed to us financially and spiritually in our time of need. We recognize that we could not have done it without you and we are forever grateful to you because there were many parishes that did not come back after the terrible storm. It is widely known that many parishes were closed forever after Hurricane Katrina, but ours did not and that is because of you, your help and your generosity of spirit.

So many things have happened over this past decade. We have remodeled our gym, refurbished the administrative building and parish hall, and restored the physical plant for viable use. We have a beautiful baptismal pool, most of our 40 or so ministries are in full operation again, we have added a third Mass, and many, though not all, of our parishioners have returned to the area and continue to worship at St. Gabriel. We have newly embarked upon a fundraising campaign to provide much needed signage in front of the Church to communicate our presence to the community and as an invitation to those seeking a place to worship. All of this would not have been possible without your assistance.

So as we stop to be thankful at this time, we remember you and we want you to know that on the anniversary of Katrina we will offer a special Mass for the intentions of all those donors who helped us to rebuild or in any way helped to bring us to where we are today. We sincerely thank you and give thanks to God always for you.

Finally, Sr. Mary Joel Franks, O.S.F., died on Saturday, August 29. Sr. Joel taught at Little Flower from 1967-1969. For many years, she served as Treasurer of Marian University. Please pray for her, her family, and the Sisters of St. Francis of Oldenburg.

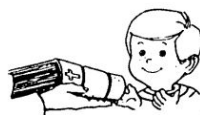
