

This week the Church celebrates the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and the Sorrows of Mary.

Monday is the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. This feast commemorates the finding of the True Cross by St. Helena, the mother of Constantine, in 320. It also commemorates the dedication of Jerusalem's Church of the Holy Sepulcher, which was rebuilt by the Crusaders, in 1149.

Tuesday is the memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows. As many of you may remember, for many years, Little Flower parishioners attended Sorrowful Mother novena devotions on Friday evenings at 7:00 p.m. The Seven Sorrows of Mary are:

- 1. The Prophecy of Simeon [Luke 2: 25-35]
- 2. The Flight into Egypt [Matthew 2: 13-15]
- 3. The Child Jesus Lost in the Temple [Luke 2: 41-50]
- 4. Mary meets Jesus carrying the cross [Luke 23: 27-29]
- 5. Mary at the foot of the cross [John 19: 25-30]
- 6. Mary receives the body of Jesus [Psalm 130]
- 7. Mary witnesses the burial of Jesus [Luke 23: 50-56]

Several weeks ago, Archbishop Tobin announced that the Archdiocese would no longer charge any fee annulments in this Archdiocese. If you have followed Catholic news this week, you probably know that Pope Francis has simplified the annulment process. I will write more about this next week.


