#### Dear Parish Family,

Congratulations to Dottie Spalding who is celebrating her 15<sup>th</sup> Anniversary as a Franciscan Associate. The Little Flower Franciscan Associates honored her last Sunday.

One of the Sisters attending her celebration was Sr. Barbara Hileman, Little Flower Class of 1947. She told me that her family moved into Little Flower the day before she started 1<sup>st</sup> grade on September 5, 1939. They moved to Little Flower because her parents had heard that Little Flower School was an excellent school.

A year or so ago, I ran into a retired real estate agent who asked me where I was pastor. When I told him Little Flower, he said that when he was a young real estate agent, one of the older real estate agents told him that for years Little Flower was a destination parish. Couples looking for homes would often call and say they wanted to move into Little Flower. I remember an article from *The Indianapolis Star* many years ago that said this neighborhood was the only Indianapolis neighborhood that real estate agents referred to by the name of its Catholic parish.

Much has changed since Sr. Barbara's parents moved into Little Flower on September 4, 1939. However, some things have remained the same. Little Flower School continues to be an excellent school. One key difference between then and now is that Sr. Barbara's parents wanted her and her siblings to have not just an excellent education but an excellent **Catholic** education. Catholic education was their prime motive for choosing a Catholic school.

Little Flower continues to give this neighborhood its identity. More importantly, Little Flower and Scecina Memorial High School are the anchors for this neighborhood. A few years ago when we were part of the Eastside church tour, several non-Catholic neighborhood residents thanked us for being here. They said that this neighborhood remains stable because of Little Flower and Scecina.

This Saturday, October 24, marks the 71<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the death of Fr. Thomas Scecina. At the time of his death, Fr. Scecina, a WWII prisoner of war, was being transported to Japan on the Arisan Maru when it was torpedoed by an Allied ship. Contrary to the rules of war, the Japanese had failed to identify the ship as a "Prisoner of War Ship." Fr. Scecina was one of 1,757 Americans lost that day when the Arisan Maru sank. Using the criteria for martyrdom of Saint Pope John Paul II, we can rightly say that Fr. Scecina was a martyr for the faith.

The Archdiocese of Indianapolis sponsors a Catholic high school in each of the four Indianapolis deaneries. As the East Deanery Catholic high school, Scecina Memorial High School is Little Flower's Catholic high school. What this means is that Scecina Memorial High School is an extension of the educational ministry of Little Flower parish and school. Today parents and students have all kinds of choices of high schools—both archdiocesan and private Catholic high schools, private high schools, charter schools, and traditional public schools. However, it is still appropriate to say that Scecina Memorial High School is our parish high school. Although I do not know this for a fact, my guess is that since its foundation in 1953 the majority of Little Flower School graduates have also graduated from Scecina Memorial High School.


