Dear Parish Family,

Last week I mentioned that Pope Francis canonized Saints Louis and Zelie Martin, the

parents of St. Therese last Sunday, October 18.

In his homily at their canonization Mass, Pope Francis said that Louis and Zelie Martin "practiced Christian service in the family, creating day by day an environment of faith and love which nurtured the vocations of their daughters, among whom was Saint Therese of the Child Jesus."

Rev. Romano Gambalunga, the postulator for their case for beatification and canonization, said, "It's the first time a couple have been canonized as a couple, and this is a beautiful sign for Christian families, who often are left without any support and have to go against the grain, especially in the West, to live and educate their children in the truth of creation and with that love that God has given us in Christ."

Before saints can be beatified and canonized, two miracles are required, one before beatification and one before canonization. Both miracles concerned the inexplicable cures of newborn children who were suffering from incurable ailments that would have taken their lives.

Indianapolis will hold elections for mayor and city council on Tuesday, November 3, 2015. Although this is an off-year election, local government often has more impact on the quality of our everyday lives than state government or the federal government. Likewise, we have a better chance of influencing local government than we do state government or the federal government. Therefore, I want to encourage all of us who are registered to vote to take the time to learn about the candidates and their positions, asking ourselves which candidates will best work to advance the common good, and to vote for these candidates on November 3. A summary of the United States bishops' reflection *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship* states, "In the Catholic Tradition, responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation."

Joe Reid, our Director of Maintenance for almost 22 years, will retire on Friday, November 13, 2015. Although Joe was Director of Maintenance for the parish, mist of his time and work was focused on the school. Therefore, on Friday, November 6, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. we will have a simple gathering with the school in Duffey Hall to celebrate his retirement. All are invited.


