

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, the final Sunday in this Church year. Today we commission all of our Liturgical Ministers except Eucharistic Ministers. Today we also want to thank them for their generous service to our community. Their ministry helps make our Liturgies beautiful.

This Thursday, November 26, is Thanksgiving Day! Our Thanksgiving Day Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. There will no other Masses or Communion Services on Thursday. Little Flower School will anticipate the celebration of Thanksgiving with an all-school Mass on Wednesday at 8:30 a.m.

We all have much for which to be grateful. The three best ways to give thanks for all our blessings on Thanksgiving Day are to celebrate Eucharist as a family, spend quality time with our family and/or friends, and share some of our blessings with those in need.

There will be a collection at the Thanksgiving Day Mass to benefit the St. Vincent de Paul Society. Because of the tough economic times, our St. Vincent de Paul Society will be stretched thinner than ever. Also, you are invited to bring food to donate. It may be placed on the steps around the altar.

You are also invited to bring food for your own dinner to be blessed. Please do not place this food on the steps. You will be invited to bring it forward to be blessed at the end of Mass.

Because of Thanksgiving, the parish offices will be closed on Thursday and Friday, November 26 and 27.

Next Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent, the beginning of a new Church year. Our Advent Penance Service will be next Monday, November 30, at Our Lady of Lourdes at 7 p.m. Please mark your calendars.

Please note the ECC Liturgical Ministry Workshop announcement immediately below my letter. One of Archbishop Tobin's decisions as part of the *Connected in the Spirit* planning process was that Holy Spirit, Little Flower, and Our Lady of Lourdes would be partnership parishes. One of the needs that all three parishes recognized was the need to strengthen training for liturgical and pastoral ministries. The workshop on Saturday, November 14, was our cohort response to that need and marked our partnership's first truly joint program. Special thanks to Diane Sharp who was one of the principal planners and coordinators of the workshop.

Please continue to pray for the victims of the terrorist attacks in Paris and for their families. Also, please pray for an end to terrorism throughout the world.

I would like to end with a wonderful story. One of our families with younger children was still at the pancake breakfast when the 10:25 bell rang for Mass last Sunday. Immediately, their 18-month-old said, "Church. Gotta go. Gotta go." Her mother said she had a look of excitement in her eyes and had her hands up and they were shaking. It would be wonderful if we were as excited to go to Mass as she was!


Please mark your calendar today for the Ladies Club Meeting on Thursday, December 3, at 7 p.m. This is our Christmas Celebration and here's what's happening:
