#### Dear Parish Family,

We welcome Fr. Patrick Cooney, OSB, as the celebrant and homilist of this week's Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. Fr. Patrick is a monk of St. Meinrad Archabbey who is serving as the Defender of the Bond at the Metropolitan Tribunal and living at Little Flower.

Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Lent, the midpoint of Lent. The Fourth Sunday of Lent was traditionally called Laetare Sunday. *Laetare* is another Latin word

that means rejoice. Therefore, priests are invited to wear rose vestments. This might be a good day to review for ourselves how we are doing keeping our Lenten promises. On Easter Sunday, we want to be able to celebrate not only Jesus' resurrection from the dead 2000 years ago but also our own resurrection to new life with him. This will only be possible to the extent that we have put to death the selfishness and sin that is part of our lives in order to rise to new life in Christ.

However, we removed them after we purchased our new hymnals because the new hymnals had all the correct responses and we had become familiar with those responses. Recently our new Evangelization Committee pointed out that visitors, especially non-Catholics, would have a hard time following the Mass using the hymnal. Therefore, they suggested adding a couple of pew cards to every pew primarily for the use of visitors.
