SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Special congratulations to Caleb Baue, son of Erin Greene Braun and stepson of Justin Braun, who was awarded the Outstanding Senior Boy Award. The nominees are nominated by seniors, and the recipient is voted on by the faculty. The award is based on all-around performance in academics, co-curriculars, and citizenship.

Caleb, Rylee Jones, Lex Martin, and Alex Quinn graduated with honors and received Academic Honors Diplomas. Wesley Moss graduated with high honors and received an Academic Honors Diploma. Anna Corner graduated with honors.

As the East Deanery Catholic High School, Seccina is Little Flower's high school, an extension of the educational ministry of Little Flower Parish. As a parish, we can be proud of the accomplishments of the Seccina Memorial Class of 2016.

At graduation, Principal John Hegarty reported that the Class of 2016 was awarded \$10.5M in scholarships. The 97 seniors were accepted at over 300 universities. Twenty of them had a GPA of a 4.0 or above.

The class Salutatorians and Valedictorian left Seccina with between 30 and 39 college credits. Equally amazing, if not more so in some ways, was that the student ranked 25th in the class, therefore not in the top 25%, left with 27 college credits.

This class was part of a softball state championship, three city championships, and four sectional championships (as of 5/27/16). In football they were part of a trip to a state championship game and won three sectional championships. Members of the Class of 2016 were also a very large part of Seccina cheerleaders winning a national cheerleader award earlier this past month.

Members of this class were the architects of are now very successful robotics team. Members of this class were instrumental in beginning the chess, rugby, and lacrosse clubs at Seccina.

In congratulating the Class of 2016, we also congratulate their parents and the faculty, staff, and administration of Seccina Memorial High School.
