The nominees are nominated by seniors, and the recipient is voted on by the faculty. The award is based on all-around performance in academics, co-curriculars, and citizenship.

In congratulating the Class of 2016, we also congratulate their parents and the faculty, staff, and administration of Scecina Memorial High School.
