Dear Parish Family,

This week I will be attending our biennial Priests' Convocation at St. Meinrad from Monday until Thursday. In his letter of invitation, Archbishop Tobin wrote, "This year we will reflect on the spirituality of mission, particularly our mission as priests and pastors." Because of the Convocation, there will be no weekday Masses this week except Friday.

Last weekend, clergy assignments were announced in the parishes affected. Fr. Rick Ginther, currently dean of the Terre Haute Deanery and pastor of St. Patrick and St. Margaret Mary parishes in Terre Haute, has been appointed pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish. Father Rick's first assignment was as associate pastor here at Little Flower from 1983 to 1985. He succeeded Fr. Paul Koetter who was associate pastor at Little Flower from 1982 to 1983. We welcome Fr. Rick to the East Deanery and to the Holy Spirit, Little Flower, Our Lady of Lourdes cohort.

At the same time, Archbishop Tobin re-appointed me Adjunct Judicial Vicar of the Archdiocese for a term of five years. This means that I will continue my work as a Presiding Judge at the Tribunal. Most of the hard work in marriage invalidity cases is done by the excellent staff at the Tribunal. In most cases, therefore, I only have to decide whether to grant the declaration of invalidity.

Congratulations to parishioner Mark Erdosy who was re-elected to serve a three-year term on the Board of Directors for the National Association for Lay Ministry (NALM). In March, he was discerned to serve as the Board Chair for a two-year term, which began on June 3, 2016. Currently, the board essentially runs the day-to-day operations of the organization. The National Association for Lay Ministry is the professional organization supporting, educating, and advocating for lay ministers by promoting the development of lay ministry in the US Catholic Church.

For those who may not know, Mark is the Executive Director of the Rebuild My Church Program and Director of the San Damiano Scholars Program for Church Leadership at Marian University. He earned a Masters of Theological Studies from Saint Meinrad School of Theology in 1995. He and his wife Tracy have been LF parishioners LF since 2004. Tracy is Little Flower Schools Pre-4 teacher. They have two daughters, Anna and Kate, who attend Little Flower School.

In matters liturgical, on June 10, 2016, at the request of Pope Francis, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, elevated the obligatory memorial of St. Mary Magdalene on July 22 to a the level of a feast day. This makes her feast of equivalent rank as the feasts of the apostles. The feast will have its own proper Preface which is titled "Apostle of the Apostles."

According to Archbishop Roche, Archbishop Secretary of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, "This decision, in the current ecclesial context, seeks to reflect more deeply upon the dignity of women, on the new evangelization and on the greatness of the mystery of God's Mercy. Saint John Paul II paid great attention not only to the importance of women in the mission of Christ and the Church, but also and with special emphasis on the particular role of Mary of Magdala as the first witness who saw the risen Christ, and as the first messenger who announced the Lord's resurrection to the Apostles..."

In my homily last Sunday, I said,

On Mount Sinai, God proclaimed himself to be a "'a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity, … but punishing children and grandchildren to the third and fourth generation for their fathers' wickedness!"' [Ex. 34:6-7].

The reference to "punishing children and grandchildren to the third and fourth generation for their fathers' wickedness" has often been misunderstood that God causes bad things to happen to children as punishment for the sins of their parents or grandparents. Nothing could be further from the truth. It means that sins often have not only long-term consequences but multi-generational consequences.

Finally, you will find the financial results from Summerfest 2016 elsewhere in this bulletin. However, I want to make you aware of something that has significantly changed these results. Last Sunday's collection contained an envelope with well over \$4,000 enclosed. There was no way to identify the donor. Because of the way the donation was packaged, we are certain that this was a donation to the festival raffle, so we are treating this donation as raffle income. This obviously has huge impact on our bottom line. Because there is no way to identify the donor, I can only hope that the donor will read this bulletin and know of my gratitude for this gift. Thank you for your generosity!
