

Wednesday I will celebrate my 41st anniversary as a priest. As most of you know, Fr. Jim Farrell and I were ordained on

June 29, 1975 by Pope Paul VI. My thirteen years here at Little Flower have been very rewarding. I am grateful to all of you for your kindness and support. I am especially grateful to the staff for all they do for me and for you.

This Thursday I will head to the lake for approximately 1½ weeks. During this time, there will be no weekday Masses here at Little Flower.
