Fr. Bob is on a well-deserved vacation. His letter will return to the bulletin in one week. Please find a letter from Kevin Gawrys, Little Flower School Principal:

On Tuesday, September 20, 2016, Little Flower will celebrate the 90th anniversary of the opening of our school. The history of our school-its alumni, the academic and athletic successes, the traditions, community, and legacy of religious vocations-is a source of great pride. We look forward to celebrating this milestone in the life of our parish throughout next school year.

This summer has been a busy one so far in the school (though not nearly as busy as when we added air conditioning last summer). Enrollment for next year is estimated to be over 290, our highest enrollment since 2005! We will now have two classrooms for Kindergarten and grades 1, 3, and 5.

Our teachers spent the first week of June preparing for next year with formative assessment training (NWEA) and a workshop, *So, You Think Your School is Inclusive*. The majority of our staff also attended a two-day, nationally renowned Literacy Retreat in French Lick. We are blessed to have such a professional, committed teaching staff.

With growing enrollment we are moving into more classroom spaces and renovating many other classrooms. This year the music room, motor skills room, and one of the first grade rooms will be getting new carpeting. Many rooms will be repainted. All of the classroom floors that are not being redone will be thoroughly stripped, waxed, or cleaned as appropriate. Thanks to Steve Clegg and his crew for their hard work.

Our theme for next school year will be *The Little Way*, as we emphasize St. Therese's commitment to doing all things, especially the little things, with great love. For 90 years Little Flower has educated the students of this community with great love and we are blessed to be able to continue this important ministry of our parish.
